Want to know more about our programme?

At what age can I enrol my child? Are there any prerequisites?

Our youngest students are in upper kindergarten. Students are grouped with peers of the same school grade to ensure their base level of development (comprehension, following instructions, reading for HKG and above) is at par.

2. How long is the programme?

The annual programme is a year long programme with breaks for summer / winter and other government holidays. The classes are held once a week for one hour — same time every week. You will receive a calendar at the time of enrolment to help plan your schedule.

3. What if the student is not able to sit through sessions?

If the student is not able to adjust to the classroom environment for up to 2 sessions, we will advise the parent to join us next year when the student feels more comfortable. We will refund the fees, if paid.

4 What if the student misses a session?

We do not offer make up turns. The onus of missed learning is on the student. Their facilitator will assist them to help catch up. We also do not allow students to change batches mid programme or attend sessions in another class as every cohort has a different dynamic and learning curve.

What happens after completion of the programme / one year?

After completion of the programme, the student will progress to the next level. There are 12 levels of the programme based on the age group.

What is the fee for this programme?

Please reach out to our enrolment team for fee details, as they differ based on levels. Our programme fee does not include the cost for Trinity examination and certification. No refunds once enrolled.

7 What is the schedule for this programme?

Please reach out to our enrolment team for the schedule, as this differs for various levels and locations, as well as open seats in that programme.

8 Can the parent / guardian sit in the classroom?

We do not permit parents / guardians to sit in the classroom or observe from outside the classroom, as this is a safe space for children to explore and work with the teacher and their peers. You may reach out to the faculty for any concerns throughout the year. It is also not allowed to wait at the premises due to regulations of the property management.

Will this age group also have examinations?

Yes, students in this programme will be taking the Trinity College London's Young Performer's Certificate examination which is a teacher-led group performance. There are no grades for this level, and each student will get an individual certificate.
